The workshop will be on Thursday 29th January 2009 at Centre Point, 103 New Oxford Street, London WC1A 1DU, taking place between 10.30 am and 4 pm. It is particularly targeted at those who rely on the UN default classification scheme for the classification of the fireworks they manufacture or import. The emphasis of the day will be on providing good practical advice to understand the classification process and to promote the prompt and efficient processing of applications. There is no cost for delegates to attend the workshop, but allocation of places will be on a first come, first served basis, on receipt of registration.
